Webinars for Foundation Dentists

The British Endodontic Society is proud to have collaborated with the UK postgraduate deaneries, under the leadership and guidance of the Dean, Dr Sana Movahedi, to deliver a series of 16 mini-webinars for Foundation Dentists (trainees) across the UK. We are grateful for the opportunity to further our charitable objectives to promote, educate, and advance Endodontology, and we sincerely appreciate access to the IT platform skilfully managed by Ms Andrea Privigyei to host these sessions via the Accent course manager system.

The webinar programme was developed in response to a growing need to support newly qualified dentists in an area consistently identified as challenging in multiple surveys. The series was organised by Dr Maria Lessani and Professor Alison Qualtrough and covered a broad range of topics aligned to the theme of delivering Endodontics in general dental practice — from diagnosis through to vital pulp therapy (VPT), root canal treatment (RCT), and medico-legal considerations. Sessions were delivered by UK experts and chaired by BES Council Members and the BES Early

Career Group committee. Each webinar followed a structured format, combining a core lecture with clinical, case-based discussion and concluding with an interactive Q&A. The RCT-focused sessions provided particularly practical, clinically relevant content, including dedicated teaching on irrigation, mechanical preparation, and obturation materials and techniques.

“Never in a million years did I believe my study would win the award. I had seen the distinguished list of previous BES prize winners, so I was very grateful, both professionally and personally, to have the honour of being amongst that list. The prize is a credit to UCL as an institution, along with my brilliant research supervisors and has given me more confidence to submit the study for publication.

“When you think of the endodontic speciality, you often think of quantitative research, microbes, outcomes, irrigation etc., but mine was qualitative research regarding restorative specialty training design. Therefore, I really encourage researchers out there to enter for these awards, you’ve worked incredibly hard on your projects, so no matter how diverse the topic, I strongly suggest submitting it to the BES for consideration.”
